Where: Rockport, Texas - Acts of Hope Center: Turning What If's Into What's Great

Team Info: This trip will be led by Reginald Eppes and is open to 20-25 people.

Team Requirements:

1. Willing to serve where needed on the team.
2. Willing to abide by a modest dress code.
3. Willing to support the mission and beliefs of First Wesleyan Church.
4. Show humility and Christ-likeness toward other team members and the people of the Rockport community.

Trip Overview: Acts of Hope Center (AHC) is a 501c3 nonprofit organization founded for the sole purpose of applying contemporary evidence-based solutions to some of the most troubling problems of our time. Acts of Hope is a pacesetting nonprofit that empowers the socioeconomically disadvantaged to lift themselves out of poverty, and for enabling children and adults to attain their natural potential. AHC will also be opening a food service center for the Rockport community. We will serve AHC and the Rockport community by...

- Picking up debris
- Fence repair
- Fixing windows
- Building seating areas
- Wall repair/painting
- Providing/passing out Bibles to the community and prayer to those in need.

Trip Cost: \$199 per person. Includes transportation, lodging, and meals.

Recommended Immunizations: We encourage you to be up to date on your tetanus vaccination.

- We will be staying at a local church, First Baptist Rockport, 1515 N. Live Oak Street. Rockport, TX 78382.
- Air mattresses will be provided but you will need to bring a pillow, blanket, sleeping bag, towels and personal hygiene products.
- Laundry and showers are available onsite.
- Deet mosquito spray. Although it is okay to wear shorts on the work sites, you may want to wear light weight pants and long sleeve t-shirts because there are LOTS of mosquitos in the summer.
- A more detailed agenda will be given before departure but for now, plan to start each day by 8:00 a.m. and end each day by 4:00 p.m.
