Register for RYM by May 15! We will be attending this great conference from July 8-13 in Laguna Beach, FL. All rising 9th graders-graduation seniors are encouraged to attend.

If you are new to OPPC, this is the highlight of the year for our youth. Talk to anyone who has attended in the past, and they will tell you how the Lord has blessed this conference.

RYM stands for Reformed Youth Ministries, and they have served the church for over 40 years by providing conferences for youth that are word-driven, God-centered, and gospel-focused.
