FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR 2025

We gratefully inform you that we received a total of \$562,975 in offerings to our 2025 Ministry Plan. However, this was \$25,169 short of our Budgeted Goal.

Although some of our planned disbursements were lower than expected, only \$5,224 remained in receipts before the planned disbursement to Denominational Missions of \$19,800.

Upon consultation with staff and a vote of your Board of Finance, the 2025 Denominational Missions payments were reduced to \$8,500, with \$3,276 of this amount being transferred from our general fund reserve, and distributed as follows:

Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (Global)	\$2,500
Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (NC)	\$4,500
Alliance of Baptists	\$1,000
Identity Partners	\$500

Our 2025 Unified Budget Offering receipts were higher than last year, but so was our budget. During 2025 we received \$28,224 in additional mission contributions (outside of the Budget) for local benevolences, Backpack Buddies, Lakeside Involved, Gatekeepers Workcamp and the food drive collections for United Community Ministries. We also received \$144,057 in contributions to the Corbi Bulluck Children's Legacy Endowment, Lakeside Endowment, Gosset-Biggs Music Fund, Youth Trip Fund, Wright Commons, memorials, and advent poinsettias.

Through the generosity of our congregation and friends, we received monetary contributions totaling over \$735,256.

Thank you to everyone who contributed to the Missions and Ministries of Lakeside in 2025. Your generosity supports God's work in our church and community.
