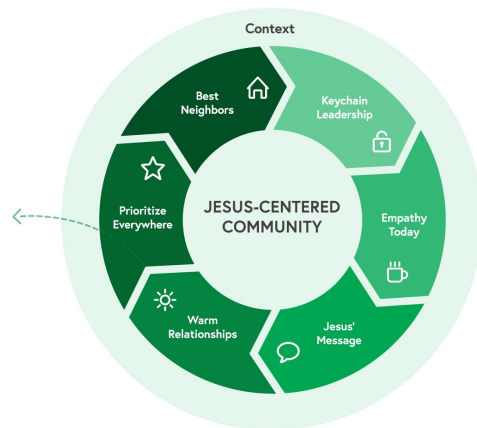
What do these phrases mean? And what do they have to do with Lakeside and our "Growing Young and Growing Together"?
