COVERED DISH FELLOWSHIP SUPPER

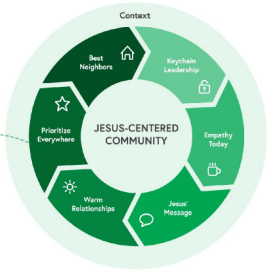
SUNDAY, OCTOBER 13, 6:00 P.M. – ROBBINS HALL
