## LAKESIDE INVOLVED!

Many thanks to all who were involved in Lakeside's annual day of ministry to our community! The children enjoyed a fun time together with friends from the Bassett Center at the Bowling Mix and Mingle. Dozens of you baked dozens of delicious goodies that the youth sold at the Treat Tasting and Cider Sipping, which raised \$1,416 for Polka Dot Mama Melanoma Foundation in memory of Niki McAdams. All remaining cookies were then delivered to the UCM Homeless Shelter, along with a truckload of household supplies. The Villa Neighborhood Park was landscaped and the Little Free Library will be restocked with donated children's books. Some of you made or delivered soup to our fellow members, while others did yard work or helped paint at the new Peacemakers facility. One team stitched dream pillows and another pieced together colorful lap blankets which were given to the Child Advocacy Center for abused children. Life Packs and Comfort Kits were filled with needed supplies for disaster relief and baby gifts were brought for a hearing impaired and homeless mother-to-be. And on Monday, 26 pints of blood were collected for the American Red Cross while volunteers assisted with setup, check in, and cleanup. We are also grateful for all who gave monetary donations to fund these various projects and to all who used their talents so generously to help others.

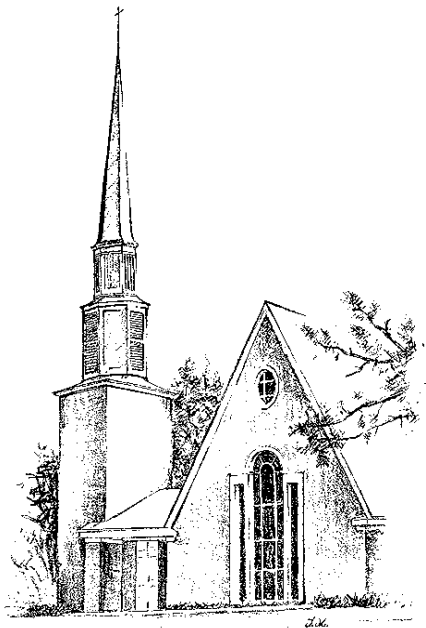
