#### UPDATE FROM THE PULPIT COMMITTEE

The Pulpit Committee has been busy since we last reported to you in late September. We meet regularly and have posted our Senior Minister position with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship in North Carolina and CBF Global in Atlanta, with the Alliance of Baptists and with the seminaries/divinity schools at Wake Forest, Campbell, Duke, Princeton, Mercer, Baylor, SMU, Emory, and Union Presbyterian. We continue to receive responses and recommendations from the individuals we contacted initially for references, and we have received resumes from as far away as Alabama and Texas and as close as Wilson County. We have developed an Application and Statement of Interest form we are requesting each interested candidate to complete and submit in order to be considered and have created an interview questionnaire for our interviews with candidates. Because of the information available online through the internet, we are able to see many of the candidates in their worship services and they can view our website and view our worship services and learn of our missions and activities. Candidates have given us very positive feedback on the information we have provided and what they have seen on our website. We are beginning to receive completed Applications and Statements of interest from candidates and are making plans to begin actual interviews soon. Our goal is to have our new Senior Minister begin on May 1, 2024 following a three-month interim period during which our pulpit will be filled by Rev. Edwards and guest speakers. We remain very committed to our task and appreciate your confidence. We will be grateful for your continued prayers for our Church, our Committee, and our search.
