2024 OFFERING ENVELOPES

We are changing how we distribute offering envelopes since now we give in a variety of ways. For example, someone who donates monthly will receive 15 envelopes. Someone who gives quarterly will receive seven. Those who no longer use envelopes will not receive any. This change will result in significant savings.
