We will send our teams of teenage and adult volunteers who give freely of their time and energy to perform free home repairs for homeowners. Our goal is to do good work on projects and build bridges of friendship within the team and with you.

Our work teams are not professional contractors, however we aim to do good quality work that will be a service to you. The team will consist of adults and teenagers. Our teams will do basic home repair projects including painting, yard work (i.e. planting flowers, trimming, and general clean-up), house cleaning, drywall, carpentry, porch and deck repairs, limited roof, electrical, plumbing and masonry work. Most team members are church-affiliated.

Teams are directly supervised by adult leaders. The teams consist of church members, sometimes pastors, teachers, elders, deacons and trustees who enjoy helping young people learn to serve.

WHO CAN APPLY?

1. You must be age 55 or older or be on documented disability.
2. You must own your home and live in it.
3. You must live in the McDonald borough or neighboring communities.

We will not be able to help everyone who applies. Once we receive your application we will review the work request and contact you to discuss the project. If the project seems to be within our scope of work we will schedule a visit to determine the material cost and project time. Our Project Committee will make the final decision on projects to be selected and notify the homeowners of our decision.
