### **HOMEOWNER APPLICATION – page 2 of 2**

We will send our teams of teenage and adult volunteers who give freely of their time and energy to perform free home repairs for homeowners. Our work teams are not professional contractors, however we aim to do good quality work that will be a service to you. The team will consist of adults and teenagers. Most team members are church-affiliated. Our teams will do basic home repair projects including interior and exterior painting, yard work (i.e. planting flowers, trimming, and general clean-up), house cleaning, small drywall repairs, carpentry, porch and deck repairs, masonry repairs including walls and walkways, and some electrical and plumbing projects.

**Teams are directly supervised by adult leaders.** The teams consist of church members, sometimes pastors, teachers, elders, deacons and trustees who enjoy helping young people learn to serve.

#### WHO CAN APPLY?

- 1. You must be age 55 or older or be on documented disability.
- 2. You must own your home and live in it.
- 3. You must live in the McDonald borough or neighboring communities.

We will not be able to help everyone who applies. Once we receive your application, we will review the work request and contact you to discuss the project. If the project seems to be within our scope of work, we will schedule a visit to determine the materials and project time needed. Our Project Committee will make the final decision on projects to be selected and notify the homeowners of our decision.
