Pastor's Page — Anticipating Pentecost

After Jesus said these things he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. Men of Galilee, they said, why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven. Acts 1:9-11

This is an incredible moment. God did not want the disciples to think for even one minute that they had time to spare. God did not want them standing there feeling bad for themselves or wondering if they were supposed to be sad that Jesus had been caught up into heaven. As they were still looking up into the sky, two men dressed in white stood beside them. The language here is amazing. They were still looking up at the sky "as he was going." The text makes it clear that though a cloud was obstructing their view Jesus was still on his way up to heaven. The disciples would have been crazy to look away at this pivotal moment. And yet these two heavenly visitors come to them and question them for looking up. The disciples needed a bit of instruction here and sometimes an outrageous question creates the teaching moment that is needed.

The message that these visitors brought is a profound one. Jesus will come back in the exact same way in which you just witnessed him depart. Don't look up into the sky and ask why he had to leave, or feel like you have been abandoned. Look, here we are giving you instructions, will not God be faithful to you as you continue following him? You are the chosen disciples of Jesus, do the things that Jesus told you to do! Have you ever lacked for anything? You will not go without whatever it is you need now either.

The disciples took the message to heart and went about all of the tasks that were important for their fledgling group. Because of their calling and obedience Jesus would use them in ways that they never could have imagined.

As we pursue our future together as a congregation, may we be like the disciples who listened and obeyed. May we also be ones who love and invest in one another while proclaiming the truth of Jesus Christ to the world. Please pray for our leaders and for all of us to step into the ways of Christ so that we may have the extraordinary confidence of the disciples. Who knows what might happen as we take new steps of faith to become better equipped in the Word of God and find ways to joyfully walk with new believers.

May this Pentecost be an incredible time of spiritual refreshing for all of us.
