And do this, understanding the present time (kairos): The hour (chronos) has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. Romans 13:11

Therefore, as we have opportunity (kairos), let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers. Galatians 6:10

I tell you, now is the time (kairos) of God's favor, now is the day of salvation. II Corinthians 6:2

I am excited to announce, on behalf of Session, that our Café now has a name! All through the design and build process we have been wondering, “What should we call this new space?” There were ideas tossed around and AI was asked a few times to help us out, but nothing seemed to stick. Perhaps we needed to be in the space for us to truly be able to understand what it was going to be like. For a while, some were starting to wonder if the space would get a special name at all. As we prayed and kept asking the question, one of our members proposed a name that connected, “Kairos Café.”

In a recent sermon on Romans 13 I was explaining how New Testament Greek has two different words for time. One word, *chronos* represents measured and static passing of time. Chronos time is important but it is grounded in the reality of days and seasons. On the other hand, another word, *kairos* has the meaning of special time, appointed time, or opportunity. Our God is one who orchestrates many special moments. When we are living by the Spirit we have chances to spend special time with the people we love and friends and neighbors. Kairos opportunities are times that we cannot “get back.” They are special moments, windows where connection and help can be offered or received, and moments when God’s grace can enter into our everyday lives.

It turns out the Kairos Café name perfectly speaks to the hope and vision of what we want to see happen in our church. Special moments, set aside by God to connect, encourage, and deepen faith. We love the name and are excited to finish decorating the space. Part of the fun of the name is that all of us will know a Greek word with a powerful truth behind it and can explain its meaning to friends and visitors to our church.

We pray that our Lord Jesus would give you many special moments of connection and faith, not only in the Kairos Café but in every space of your life.

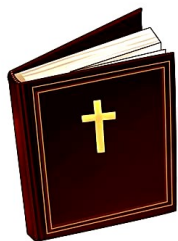
Announcements

It is finally happening! Our new boiler for Calvary Center is being installed as I am writing this article and I feel like it is Christmas morning. Our old boiler served us proudly for some 40 years, but it was well past its lifespan. It was costing us three thousand dollars or more a year to keep running and was very inefficient. The valves were leaking and rust was taking over some of the key junctions. We were left cold too many Sunday mornings and were huddled around electric heaters on more than one occasion. Because of God's grace and faithfulness, we have been able to select a state-of-the-art system that is being installed by true professionals. Where before we had a tangle of pipes that was the cause of nightmares, now we have a beautiful wall of organized valves and junctions that will serve us for generations to come. We are moving from about 50% efficiency up to 95% and we are looking forward to seeing some advantages in our utility bills. Many thanks to our outstanding Buildings and Grounds team who have put a great deal of effort into ensuring that this is a generational improvement for our congregation. Also, thank you to all who give so faithfully to our congregation so that improvements like this can be accomplished and our facilities can continue to be a resource for sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ.
