Description:

REMERGE is an innovative community building and facilitating team that mobilizes Christians, churches and organizations for reconciliation and justice. We are looking for interns that are creative, energetic and interested in learning about applying commitments to reconciliation across varied sectors and in a neighborhood context.

As an intern you will experience a challenging and rigorous time of learning and growth through exploring life in community with the vulnerable, participating in hands-on work, and theological reflection. You will live and work in diverse communities alongside the poor and homeless, at-risk youth, and women and men being trafficked. You will also be exposed to the administrative, strategic and organizational side of running a non-profit. In addition, you will read books and articles, complete reflection and writing assignments, and be fully immersed in our innovative design philosophy.

Responsibilities include:

- Participate with one of our communities.
- Assist in the day-to-day activities of the organization.
- Learn and help to lead our innovative design approach including theology, design thinking, continuous innovation formation, social change theory, and impact modeling.
- Assist in leading and logistics of educational programming.
- Assist in implementing our new strategic plan.
- Assist in our new branding and marketing initiatives.
- Complete reading assignments and participate in discussions.

- REMERGE will provide housing, a \$500 per month stipend, and required reading materials.
- The internship will begin May 15th and conclude August 13th.
