

Student Guidelines for OHSM:

Our Core Values: The 5 M's of Student Ministry

4. Partner with MOM AND DAD. Parents are a constant influence in the life of a student and we should work together to develop godly men and women.
5. Create space for God MOMENTS. God can do what we can't. We must create environments and opportunities for Him to move in the lives of our students.

Campus Security:

The safety of your student(s) has been one of the main priorities of our church. Therefore, there are a few things you should know, and expect to see at OHBC:

1. We have installed an extra LED Parking Lot spotlight that will shine directly on the Student Ministry entrance to brighten it up at night times.
2. We have a security check-in system that we use for both Sunday morning and Wednesday night activities to ensure the safety of your student(s).
3. You can expect to see an individual in the main entrance on Sunday mornings keeping an eye on who enters and exits our building.
4. During Wednesday Night activities, our life group leaders will be performing periodical walk- throughs of our Student Ministry wing, and all exterior doors will be locked 15 minutes after high school youth group begins on Wednesday nights.
5. On Sunday mornings you will find the Sunday School classrooms being unlocked 15 minutes prior to the start time, and only if the Sunday School Teacher is present. Additionally, all doors in the Student Ministry wing will be locked immediately following the conclusion of Sunday School.
