DOXOLOGY UPDATE

After months of preparations, the Doxology Conference, which will feature Dr. John Kleinig's presentation on Christian sexuality, is upon us. The conference will be here at Trinity on Saturday, Aug. 25 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. If you haven't signed up for this amazing opportunity, you can do so on the morning of the conference. The cost for the conference is \$15 for adults and \$8 for students, which includes college, seminary and high school students. More than 160 people from Wisconsin, Illinois, Iowa, Minnesota, Michigan and Missouri already have registered.

SECURITY UPDATES BEGIN

New security measures are being put into place as we begin another school year. The biggest change: The front door will be locked during school and Shining Stars (after-school) hours. How does this affect you? When you come to the school door, you will find an intercom box. You will need to push the button and stand in front of this box as there is a camera involved, and speak to the office staff about who you are and why you are present.

The office staff may ask you for more information. After this conversation, you will be buzzed into the building. Once inside, you will be required to sign-in at the reception desk. This sign-in procedure is for security and safety. We certainly don't want to mistrust any of our dear members. However, please keep in mind that we have you sign in so that we have an accurate accounting of who is in the building.

This becomes essential information for law enforcement in the case of any type of emergency. For after-hour events, things will continue to function much the same way as in the past. It is critical that all events be listed on either the church or the school calendar as the calendar is how we determine when doors to be locked and unlocked.

Additional updates are in the works to ensure the safety of our ChurchSchool.

An email will be coming very soon that outlines all of the items on the list for Phase 1 of this project.
