ALTAR CROSS

Did you notice the crucifix in the Welcome Center as you came into church today? It's the one that sat on Trinity's altar when the church was on 15th and Marquette streets in Davenport. Most recently, the altar cross was used in the 11 a.m. contemporary service. The cross was knocked over last year in the space crunch of classrooms, and the corpus was broken. Repairs were attempted, but the age of the materials made the repair too difficult.

The new corpus is very close to the original in size and style. It has been hand carved and painted by artisans in Italy.
