## SAFETY BLESSINGS

In the past couple of months, Trinity Lutheran's safety committee has communicated a plan and the need for funding to improve the security of our church and school.

God's people here at Trinity Lutheran ChurchSchool have responded in a mighty way.

Initial costs to cover the first phase of security updates totaled between \$25,000 and \$30,000.

To date, more than \$30,000 has been donated through the generosity of our Trinity family. God's people are so generous.

While building safety and security have been a topic of discussion for the past several years, our recent NLSA site visit brought a new urgency for action.

Through the help of God's people, Trinity Lutheran has responded by replacing the main entrance of the school with a new structure, doors, glass and a buzz-in system.

The plan for a vestibule in the main entrance of the school, plus interior and exterior cameras along with trauma kits and escape ladders also will be added.

Stay tuned as we continue to make security improvements to our facility to insure the safety of those – big and small - in our church and school.
