LENTEN OPPORTUNITIES

*"...how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth."
(1 Timothy 3:15)*

We are all born sinful.

In Baptism, faith is created in us and we become children and heirs of God. As we hear the Gospel and receive the Lord's Supper, that Christian faith is fed and nourished.

But what does our new life, now saved, look like? How is the life of a Christian any different than the life of an unbeliever? Pastor Will Weedon's book: Thank, Praise, Serve and Obey: Recover the Joys of Piety, will address these questions.

Pastor Weedon's book is the focus of this year's Lenten small group Bible studies. This year's Lenten Bible study theme is Learning Godly Habits. Both the book and theme also will guide the course of our midweek Lenten worship services/sermons, as well.

There are many opportunities to be a part of Trinity's Lenten Bible study. Sign-up sheets are located on the table in the narthex.

You can join an existing group, or form a new one. Groups meet weekly through Lent, and are encouraged to continue meeting beyond Lent, monthly or however often the group decides.
