FAMILY DISCUSSION GUIDE

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 11

Worship is a foundational part of following Jesus. Worship reflects the heart and one's attitude towards God. Unfortunately, most people find themselves worship God on Sundays, and then they worship other things throughout the week. It is far too easy to make it appear that you are worshipping God, but instead, you let your heart focus on other things. That is the picture we read about in 1 Kings 18. The Israelites show us that people haven't changed much over time. They knew how to follow God and knew God's power in their life. Yet, they worshipped a false god, Baal. For Christians today, we need to know that Jesus is concerned with who and how we worship.

QUESTIONS FOR YOUNG KIDS

- Who was Elijah? Which God did he believe in?
- What did God do on Mt. Carmel?
- Why can you trust God?

QUESTIONS FOR JUNIOR HIGH AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- How would you define faith?
- How does Elijah show great faith in this story?
- How does God prove his trustworthiness?

GENERAL QUESTIONS

- How does this story point us to Jesus and the gospel message?
- How does this story help us better understand God and His kingdom?
- How does this story help us better understand our responsibility as Christians?

APPLICATION

- In your relationship with God, does it feel distant or intimate? Why or why not?
- Reflect on the desires of your heart. Does your heart worship God or other things?
- How can you focus more of your life on God? How can you increase your posture of worship towards God?
