STANDARD OBJECTIVE: LOVE GOD

WORSHIP TEAM MEMBER: INSTRUMENTALIST

This person helps others love God by participating in the worship band. Flexible scheduling, but usually twice a month with practice on Sunday from 8:15 - 9:30 AM.

WORSHIP TEAM MEMBER: VOCALIST

This person helps others love God by singing in the worship band. Flexible scheduling, but usually twice a month with practice on Sunday from 8:15 - 9:30 AM.

WORSHIP TEAM MEMBER: AUDIO/VIDEO TECH

This person helps others love God by mixing sound and/or handling projection. Flexible scheduling, but usually twice a month with practice on Sunday from 8:15 - 9:30 AM.

STANDARD OBJECTIVE: LEARN ABOUT GOD & LIVE OUT FAITH

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEAM MEMBER: 0 TO 24 MOS

This person helps parents with infants love God by providing safe and age-appropriate ministry to their children while they worship. Flexible scheduling, but once or twice a month on Sundays from 9:40-11:40 AM.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEACHER: 2 TO 4 YRS

This person helps parents with preschoolers love God by providing safe and age-appropriate ministry to their children while they worship. The Children's Director provides this person with the lesson and materials they need to be effective. Flexible scheduling, but usually once or twice a month on Sundays from 9:40-11:40 AM.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEACHER ASSISTANT: 2 TO 4 YRS

This person helps parents with preschoolers love God by providing safe and age-appropriate ministry to their children while they worship. This person is responsible for helping the teacher and students with crafts, games, and other lesson components. Flexible scheduling, but once or twice a month on Sunday from 9:40-11:40 AM.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEACHER: 5 YRS TO 4TH GRADE

This person helps parents with elementary children love God by providing safe and age-appropriate ministry to their children while they worship. The Children's Director provides this person with the lesson and materials they need to be effective. Flexible scheduling, but once or twice a month on Sunday from 9:40-11:40 AM.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY TEACHER ASST: 5 YRS TO 4TH GRADE

This person helps parents with elementary children love God by providing safe and age-appropriate ministry to their children while they worship. This person is responsible for helping the teacher and students with crafts, games, and other lesson components. Flexible scheduling, but once or twice a month on Sunday from 9:40-11:40 AM.

STUDENT MINISTRY TEAM MEMBER: MIDDLE OR HIGH SCHOOL

This person will help middle and/or high school students learn about God and live out their faith. They will help students make friends, engage with Scripture, and learn to love Jesus for themselves. During each season this person will help the Student Ministry Director plan 2-3 parties for the students. This person may share teaching responsibilities with the Middle or High School Directors. Usually this person serves twice a month during the sermon portion of the Sunday worship service.

STUDENT MINISTRY TEAM MEMBER: MIDDLE SCHOOL DIRECTOR

This person will help middle school students learn about God and live out their faith. LIFE GROUP LEADER - COLLEGE

This person will help college age people learn about God and live out their faith by using our curriculum to prepare and share a Bible study with them as well as organize opportunities for the group to meet casually. The

meeting times and places are flexible, depending on when college age people can meet.

LIFE GROUP LEADER

This person will help make friends through an age-specific or interest-specific community group. What the group does, when they meet, and where they meet is up to the group leader.

LEARNING GROUP LEADER

This person will help people learn about God and live out their faith by planning, preparing, and sharing a Bible study or faith-oriented learning experience with them. If the person prefers it, the Community Groups Director can purchase a premade group study for this person to use. Scheduling is flexible, but usually groups meet at least twice a month for an hour at the church or another place (i.e. coffee shop or home).

STANDARD OBJECTIVE: LEAD PEOPLE TO JESUS

OUTREACH TEAM MEMBER

This person will help us lead people to Jesus by assisting the Local Outreach Director plan, prepare, and execute local outreach events, especially during Seasons of Outreach. Flexible scheduling, but plan on meeting 2-3 times over the course of 4-5 months, plus whatever time it takes to prepare the outreach events.

GLOBAL MISSIONS DIRECTOR/LIAISON

This person will help us lead people to Jesus by communicating with our missionaries every 4-6 months and then sharing the missionary's updates with the congregation. This person will assist the Lead Pastor and the Local Outreach Director Seasons of Outreach. Plan on about 1 hour per month.

STANDARD OBJECTIVE: LUGNUTS (LEND A HAND)

PRAYER TEAM MEMBER

This person helps others in difficult times by supporting them through prayer. There is no set schedule for this person, but they minister as needed.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS TEAM MEMBER: GREETER

This person helps others make friends by welcoming them as they enter the church, helping them get where they need to go, and connect with potential friends. Flexible scheduling, but usually once or twice a month on Sundays from 9:40 to 10:05 AM.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS TEAM MEMBER: SERVICE GREETER

This person helps others by monitoring the main entrance during ministry times. Flexible scheduling, but usually once a month on Sundays from 10:00 to 11:30 AM.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS TEAM MEMBER: HOSPITALITY

This person helps others feel welcome and make friends by preparing coffee and snacks for them to eat before church. This person serves on Sunday mornings from 8:30 to 10:00 AM.

FINANCE TEAM MEMBER: USHER/COUNTER

This person helps others by collecting their offerings which fund the church's ministries and missions. Each week two of the ushers will prepare the offering for deposit by counting it. Flexible scheduling, but plan on 15 to 30 minutes one to three times per month.

TECHNOLOGY ASSISTANT

This person will help church leaders perform their roles by assisting them use their church Google account, the church's Apple computers and iPads, as well as how to effectively operate the copier, TV's, and sound bars in the church. There is no set schedule for this person, but they minister as needed (on average 1-1.5 hours per month).

FACILITIES TEAM MEMBER

This person helps others by keeping the facilities up to date and clean. There is no set schedule for this person, but they minister as needed. For instance, in the winter this person would arrive early to salt the sidewalks. In the summer, this person will assist the Facilities Director in preparing the sprinkler system. Throughout the year, there are small projects that need to be done and this person will help with those projects.
