ANSWERS TO FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What additional steps are you taking to make Cornerstone Kids safe (and fun) for our family?

- We've increased hygiene and cleaning protocols in our Cornerstone Kids spaces during service.
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations will be available at the Cornerstone Kids check-in stations as well as every classroom.
- All toys and hard surfaces will be sanitized frequently.

Will the check-in process be any different?

- We will have the iPads available for digital check-in. We will have Connect Team Members regularly wiping these down after each use. Please take some time and update your Planning Center account with your child's information for faster check-in.
- We encourage you to only send one parent into the Cornerstone Kids hallways for drop-off and pick-up to help limit traffic in the hallways.

Will my child be required to wear a mask?

Children under 10 are not required to wear a mask. However, all of our volunteers will be asked to wear a mask while they are serving in Children's Ministry.

Will you be checking temperatures at check-in?

We will not be checking temperatures upon check-in. If your child, looks sick or acts sick we will ask that you take them home. We will be strictly enforcing our Well Child Policy.

We all need to work together to help keep our Cornerstone Kids safe, so please stay home and participate online if your child:

- Has not been symptom-free for 3 days.
- Had initial COVID-like symptoms in the past 10 days.
- Had exposure to someone with a probably or lab-confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis within the past 14 days.
