What is a Stewardship AND Capital Campaign?

Stewardship pledges fund our ongoing ministry. In 2026, we are moving to a calendar year budget. Your gifts will be used to carry out our shared mission and ministry.

A **Capital Campaign** is for the purpose of caring for and enhancing a building. They are additional funds that are raised in addition to the annual stewardship budget. A capital campaign can also include managing, reducing, and eventually eliminating, a mortgage.

Why Do We Need a Capital Campaign Now?

Our building is the place we gather, and where we are Covered in God's Love. We are called to be good stewards and caretakers of our church home. Because of the immediate need for repair to protect the building from further water damage, this project is almost complete! The church council voted to move forward, with faith and confidence that we will provide the gifts necessary to pay for the project.

What are the Objectives of the Capital Campaign?

There are three, in order of funding priorities:

- Caring for Our Church Home
- Enhancing Fellowship
- Eliminating Our Mortgage

What about my Annual Stewardship Pledge and Giving?

An overall increase of approximately 3% over 12 months is projected just to maintain pace with inflation as we continue to fulfill our mission to *know Christ and make Christ known*.
