



Beyond – January 6

Memorize Ephesians 3:20-21. Read some of the passages below and consider what it means to know that God’s power is at work within us. (2 Corinthians 4:7, 1 Corinthians 12:9-10, 2 Corinthians 13:4, Philippians 3:10, 2 Timothy 1:7)

Beyond Creation – January 13

Write out the text of Ephesians 1:1–14, a few verses at a time, jotting down your questions and reactions.

Beyond Borders – January 20

What borders or barriers have you built in your own life that prevent you from living “on mission”? How can you move beyond those borders and begin to live “on mission”?

Beyond Salvation – January 27

Read Matthew 4:19. A disciple is someone who is following Christ, being changed by Christ and is on mission with Christ. Does this describe your relationship with Jesus?

Beyond Limits – February 3

Read John 3:16. We are generous because we have a generous God. What are some practical ways you can be Sacrificially Generous with your time, talent and treasures?

Beyond Forgiveness – February 10

Read Ephesians 2:8-10. Spend this week thanking God for his grace to you through Jesus and ask him to guide you into the life and work he has for you.

Beyond Hurt – February 17

Read Matthew 18:21-35. Is there anyone you need to ask forgiveness from? Ask God to show you and reach out this week. Is there anyone you need to forgive? Write a letter of forgiveness, whether you send it or not, to someone who’s hurt you badly.

Beyond Ourselves – February 24

Memorize Philippians 2:3-4. What are the needs of some of the people in the community around you? How can you help meet those needs?

Praying Beyond – March 3

Read Matthew 6:9-13. This week pray the Lord’s Prayer. Don’t simply recite it, but pray it with true meaning.
