

To ensure excellence, the following guidelines are top priority:

Safety/Security

All volunteers are screened through background checks.

Mandatory child/parent security tags ensure safe drop off and pick up.

Parent pagers allow contact when communication is necessary.

A parent is paged if the child cannot be consoled within 15 minutes.

Health

Facilities and toys are sanitized each week.

For protection, a child may not enter the preschool area with the following:

A temperature over 99.5 (and must be fever free for 24 hours)

A cold, sore throat, excessive sneezing, and/or persistent cough

Swollen glands

Earache

Red or sore eyes

Discharge from nose, eyes, ears other than allergies

Vomiting within the last 24 hours

Diarrhea

Skin rashes

Signs of listlessness, weakness, drowsiness, headache

Signs compatible with a communicable disease or exposure to one

Requests/Tips/Other information

Please label bag and ALL contents and bring the following:

A disposable diaper (if not potty trained)

A change of clothes (up to recently potty trained)

Bottle and pacifier (for infants)

Snacks are provided (water and various crackers for toddler and older)

Provide information to volunteers of any allergies or special needs to care for your child at check in
