As a believer in Christ, have you come to know and believe the love that God has for you? Let's look to the following passages of Scripture this week and grow in the glorious truth of God's faithful love for His people.

GOD'S WORD

For the Week

MONDAY :: Read **ROMANS 8:35-39**

Paul answers the question he raised in Romans 8:35 with *absolute certainty* that nothing can ever sever people from God's love in Christ. **How comforting that truth is for us each day! Choose to rest in that certainty this week.**

TUESDAY :: Read PSALM 36:5-7

These verses express God's enduring commitment to act kindly toward His creatures and to save them. **This week, take refuge under His wings and find yourself a welcome guest at His table of fellowship.** These blessings are yours because of Christ Jesus!

WEDNESDAY :: Read JOHN 3:16

Likely the most famous summary of the gospel in the entire Bible. God's love for "the world" made it possible for "whoever" believes in Christ, not Jews alone, to have eternal life. **God's love was demonstrated by the act of sending His Son.** **How will you choose to show love to others through your actions this week?**

THURSDAY :: Read ROMANS 5:7-8

Speaking to those who have believed in Christ (cf., Rom. 5:1), Paul proves that God's love is committed, faithful, and merciful in that Christ died for us while we were in willful rebellion against God. **In view of the gospel, we are not only called to love those who are easy to love, but also those who may not be "for us" in the moment.**

FRIDAY :: Read ISAIAH 54:10

God's love for his people is not just a little greater than His wrath; it is massively greater and eternally unchanging! **Today, if you are in Christ, take a moment to intentionally focus upon the reality that God truly and deeply and greatly loves you. He really does!**

SATURDAY :: Read LAMENTATIONS 3:22-24

God's "steadfast love" could also be described as His "covenant mercy" or beneficial action on His people's behalf. Notice that it never ceases! **God doesn't love you according to your performance for Him, but according to Christ's performance for you!**

SUNDAY :: Read PSALM 100

Such an encouraging passage of Scripture. Ask the Lord to prepare your heart and mind to receive His Word today.
