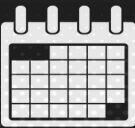

During Christmastime we will be focusing upon the significance of the eternal Son of God assuming a human nature. One of the things Jesus came to do was to die as the perfect atoning sacrifice for the sins of His people. Let's study that this week.

GOD'S WORD
For the Week

MONDAY :: Read 1 JOHN 4:10

God's immense love for us is seen in the sending of His Son to make atonement for our sins. Another word for atonement is "propitiation." That means to satisfy or absorb God's wrath. *Jesus came to bear the wrath of God that we deserve. If you are in Christ, you receive the full and free welcome of God and never need to fear His wrath against you!*

TUESDAY :: Read GALATIANS 3:13

There was no escape from the curse of God's law. It was just; we were guilty. There was only one way to be free: someone must pay the penalty. *This verse teaches that the law's demands have been fulfilled by Christ's perfect law-keeping, its penalty fully paid by His death. Jesus came so that we would escape the curse of the law!*

WEDNESDAY :: Read ROMANS 5:10

The reconciliation that needs to happen between humanity and God goes both ways. God took the steps to remove His own judgment by sending Jesus to suffer in our place. *Jesus came to reconcile us to God. Reconciliation on our side is simply to receive what God has already done, the way we receive an infinitely valuable gift.*

THURSDAY :: Read JOHN 3:16

The measure of God's love is shown by the degree of His sacrifice in saving us from the penalty of our sins: "He gave His one and only Son." The measure of His love increases still more when we consider the degree of our unworthiness. Jesus came to show God's love for sinners. *Our debt is so great, only a divine sacrifice could pay it.*

FRIDAY :: Read GALATIANS 2:20

The death of Christ is the supreme expression that He "loved me and gave Himself for me." It is my sin that cuts me off from God. Jesus paid the highest price possible to give me—personally—the greatest gift possible. *Jesus came to show His own love for us!*

SATURDAY :: Read ROMANS 8:1

The great conclusion to the suffering and death of Christ is this: "there is now no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus." Christ becomes our punishment (which we don't have to bear) and our worth before God (which we cannot earn). *Jesus came to take away our condemnation.*

SUNDAY :: Read JOHN 1:14

This is one of the texts for today's message. Ask the Lord to prepare your heart and mind to receive His Word today.
