As we continue to move forward in the book of Genesis, we are approaching the disastrous fall into sin. Next week Pastor Kevin will look at the fall and its effects. This week, let's consider some Scriptures on the subject of sin and our need for God's grace.

## GOD'S WORD *For the Week*

### MONDAY :: Read **EPHESIANS 2:1-10**

Before God made us alive with Christ (v. 5), we were spiritually dead in sin. The choice to sin didn't merely cause the severing of our fellowship with God, it resulted in our incapacity for right and good spiritual desires and spiritual life. ***What mercy God has shown to those powerless to save themselves by giving us new life with Christ! Dwell on this glorious grace today.***

### TUESDAY :: Read **EZEKIEL 36:26-27**

How wonderful are these New Covenant promises! God promises to remove the heart of stone from His people and give them new hearts that can trust and obey properly. ***These promises are ultimately realized as the Spirit of God applies the redemptive blessings of Christ to the people of God. If you are in Christ, God has given you a new mind and a new heart!***

### WEDNESDAY :: Read **JEREMIAH 17:9**

In no uncertain terms does the prophet Jeremiah declare that the sinful human heart is utterly deceitful and incurable. Only God has the power to give life to the dead and call things into existence that do not exist (Rom. 4:17). ***Throughout redemptive history God has been doing the miraculous to secure His promises and save His people. Our salvation in Christ is no different!***

### THURSDAY :: Read **ROMANS 3:10-18**

The whole world stands guilty before God. There is nothing we can do to save ourselves. Apart from Christ, there is no hope. ***Today, rest afresh upon the grace, mercy, and life that are freely yours by faith in Christ Jesus.***

### FRIDAY :: Read **1 CORINTHIANS 2:14-16**

The effects of sin are so deep that unbelievers do not have the spiritual capacity to understand the things of God. Paul used the words *οὐ δύναται* (pron. "ooo doon-ah-tie"), which are translated "is not able." It is a statement of utter inability. ***Praise God that by His Spirit, in view of Christ, He gives eternal life to undeserving sinners. His lovingkindness is glorious!***

### SATURDAY :: Read **JOHN 11:38-44**

The story of Lazarus presents us with a picture of the power of God's life-giving Word. ***If you are in Christ, God called you out of darkness and into His marvelous light!***

### SUNDAY :: Read **GENESIS 3**

This is the text for today's message. ***Ask the Lord to prepare your heart to hear from His Word today.***
