

DAILY BIBLE STUDY

FOR THE WEEK OF
January 18, 2026

One of the points emphasized in our current series is that God has not left the church without a foundational blueprint for how He desires the church to function in a healthy way. We see this in His Word generally, and in Titus specifically. Our God is a speaking God. He has revealed Himself to us in His Word. This week, let's consider the glory of God's self-revelation in Scripture.

GOD'S WORD *For the Week*

MONDAY :: Read **GENESIS 1:1-3**

The God we worship is a God who speaks. In fact, His first act recorded in the Bible was a speech act: "God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light" (Gen. 1:3). ***We should be intensely grateful that God speaks. We don't have to wonder who or what He is like...He's told us in the Bible! How closely do you listen to His Word?***

TUESDAY :: Read **HEBREWS 1:1-2**

When Adam sinned, free and direct communication with God ceased. Afterward, God spoke words of judgment and grace to His people in varied ways, but most often through ordained spokesmen called "prophets." ***Hebrews tells us, though, that the fullest revelation of God has come to us in the person of Christ. God spoke in the most personal way possible—in the person of His Son dwelling among us!***

WEDNESDAY :: Read **EPHESIANS 2:20**

God's gospel is the good news of His saving work in Jesus Christ. That message was entrusted to the Apostles and through them came the New Testament. ***This apostolic witness provides a sure foundation for the church, and cannot be surpassed, for it unerringly testifies to God's ultimate speech act, Jesus!***

THURSDAY :: Read **NUMBERS 23:19**

God is a God of truth. He never lies and is completely reliable in all He says and does. ***Because the Bible is the word of such a God, it is wholly true and reliable in all that it teaches. Ask God to help you firmly trust His Word.***

FRIDAY :: Read **2 TIMOTHY 3:16**

The holy Scriptures are the means God uses to shape our lives. Paul affirms that the Lord will equip us through His Word for whatever "good work" he requires of us. ***Are you prioritizing consistent time in God's Word so that you are always becoming better equipped to serve the Lord in whatever He gives you to do?***

SATURDAY :: Read **LUKE 24:27, 44-45**

Christ Himself is the means by which God has spoken His ultimate Word to the world. Christ Himself, in His person and work, is the gospel, and it has been authoritatively revealed to us in the Scriptures. ***Jesus is the center of the Bible! Are you in the habit of reading all of the Bible with the person and work of Jesus always in view?***

SUNDAY :: Read **PSALM 19:7-11**

This is a glorious passage on the nature of God's Word. Ask the Lord to prepare your heart and mind to receive His Word today.
