In Matthew 6:15, Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do you say I am?" That is the most important question ever asked. Your belief about and response to Jesus are the only things that will matter 100 years from now. Let's take a look at what the Bible has to say...

## GOD'S WORD For the Week

### MONDAY :: Read JOHN 6:35

Jesus is the "bread of life" in the sense that He nourishes people spiritually and satisfies the deep spiritual longing of their soul. This is the first of Jesus's seven "I am" sayings. Employing "I am" in reference to Himself, Jesus was claiming to be Yahweh (see Ex. 3:14). *Our deepest longings and search for lasting satisfaction can only be found in knowing Jesus.*

### TUESDAY :: Read JOHN 14:6-11

Jesus is the only way to God (Acts 4:12) and He alone can provide access to God. Only Jesus can confer eternal life to all those who believe in Him. *The remarkable thing isn't that there is only one way to be reconciled to God, but that there is any way at all!*

### WEDNESDAY :: Read PHILIPPIANS 2:5-7

Prior to the incarnation, Christ was in the form of God. He is the eternal Son of God who was there with the Father in the beginning. Remarkably, according to His humanity, He didn't demand the privileges that come with being God. Rather, He came to serve. *This attitude of humble servanthood is ours in Christ Jesus. Living after the example of Christ means choosing to consider the good of others before our own.*

### THURSDAY :: Read JOHN 1:1-3

These verses echo the opening phrase of the book of Genesis. In Christ, God was making all things new. *Have you been made new through faith in Christ Jesus? How is He in the process of changing you by the power of His Spirit right now?*

### FRIDAY :: Read COLOSSIANS 2:9-10

Christ is the visible expression of God. In His incarnation and now in His glorification at the right hand of the Father, Jesus is God in the flesh. *Believers share in Christ's power by virtue of our union with Him! He has broken the power of sin in your life. Choose obedience today for His glory!*

### SATURDAY :: Read LUKE 22:66-71

Jesus declares that He is not only the human Messiah anticipated by the Jews but also the divine Son of Man (Dan. 7:13-14) who sits at the right hand of God (Psalm 110:1-2) and will come in power to reign over the earth. *Is the King of the Ages ruling in your heart today?*

### SUNDAY :: Read TITUS 2:1-5

This is one of the texts for today's message. Ask the Lord to prepare your heart and mind to receive His Word today.
