

# DAILY BIBLE STUDY

February 15, 2026

In Philippians 4:8, Paul urges his readers to be deliberate in their thinking. Paying careful attention to what we set our minds on is vital to the Christian life. This week, we will examine several passages that highlight this truth.

## GOD'S WORD *For the Week*

### MONDAY :: Read ROMANS 12:2

Our minds are constantly battling between being pressed into the mold of this world or conformity to Christ. *What must happen to our minds so we may resist being molded after the pattern of this world? Our minds are renewed as we dwell upon God's Word. How are you actively putting Scripture to memory in your own life?*

### TUESDAY :: Read COLOSSIANS 3:2

Notice how we must actively and intentionally choose the direction of our thoughts. *How intentional are you concerning what you think about or what you allow to fill your thoughts? What, specifically, will you do each day to ensure that your mind is continually directed heavenward?*

### WEDNESDAY :: Read MATTHEW 22:37

One of the ways we are called to demonstrate our love for the Lord is to fully engage our minds in growing in our knowledge of him. *Has your knowledge of the Lord increased significantly over the course of your Christian life? Did you know that it is an act of worship to pursue the deep things of God?*

### THURSDAY :: Read ROMANS 8:7-8

Prior to the regenerating work of the Holy Spirit, our minds are opposed—even hostile—to the things of God. Indeed, apart from being born again by the Spirit, we will not submit to the Lord. *Do you marvel daily at the grace of God to change your mind and heart toward him? Seeing that we have been graced a new mind by the Spirit, let us use it to love and honor God!*

### FRIDAY :: Read PROVERBS 12:25

Notice how important it is to give and receive encouragement. *Do you know someone who is discouraged? Encourage them today! Point their mind to Christ!*

### SATURDAY :: Read PROVERBS 28:26

Our minds, left to ourselves, will often be the source of destruction. *Knowing this, will you make it a priority to have your mind formed according the wisdom of God's Word?*

### SUNDAY :: Read TITUS 3:8-11

This is the text for today's message. *Ask the Lord to prepare your heart to hear from His Word today.*
