DEVOTIONAL THOUGHTS

God is always working. He pursues a love relationship with us. Then--in what is the most lopsided arrangement of all--God invites us to be involved in His work. Think about that as you read the passages this week and are reminded of God's invitation to you.

MON

JAN 22

Read John 14:15-21

Note the end of v. 21 and the fact that Jesus will reveal Himself to those who love Him.

TUES

JAN 23

Read Exodus 3:1-12

Don't you wish God appeared like this all the time to tell us what to do? Think through the wonder and questions Moses had as he processed what was happening there.

WED

JAN 24

Read Exodus 3:13-17

Keep in mind the 'name of God' as given here. Again, consider God's personal call with this personal name.

THURS

JAN 25

Read Exodus 6:1-9

Note how the Lord promised the land but NOT with His personal name YHWH. God desires to work through YOU and He chooses each one of us in a personal way.

FRI

JAN 26

Read Isaiah 6:6-13

Note that God does not 'call' Isaiah, per se. Isaiah overhears God and then volunteers. Only then, does God reveal His plan for him. Will you listen as God speaks?

SAT

JAN 27

Read Jeremiah 1:4-10

I come to these verses often as a reminder of God's personal call to this prophet. By application, God does the same with us as He invites us to join Him in His work.

SUN

JAN 28

Read John 14:15-21

This will prepare your heart for the sermon today.
