

Devotional thoughts leading to January 13,  
2019

The resurrection is the key note of our faith.  
This week, we will take Jesus' allusion to what  
will come as we also note His commitment to  
what is holy.

MONDAY—read JOHN 2:13-22. The leaders ask  
for a 'sign' and look at the way Jesus responds.

TUESDAY—read LUKE 24:1-9. Coming to the  
tomb—note what the women find and what  
they remember as a result.

WEDNESDAY-- read ACTS 26:19-29. On trial for  
his life—Paul points to the resurrection as proof  
of what he is saying.

THURSDAY—read MATTHEW 16:21-28. Jesus  
tells His disciples what is to take place  
and...Peter....being Peter...Since the  
resurrection IS true—verses 24-27 take on new  
significance.

FRIDAY—read MARK 9:9-13. The disciples just  
did not understand what Jesus meant about  
rising from the dead...until He rose from the  
dead!

SATURDAY—read MARK 14:26-31. Jesus  
prepares the disciples for what is to come even  
though they don't know that yet.

SUNDAY—read JOHN 2:13-22. This will offer  
the proper background for today's sermon.
