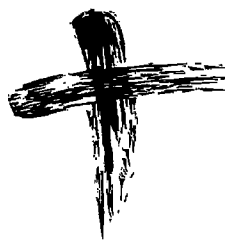


ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICE
