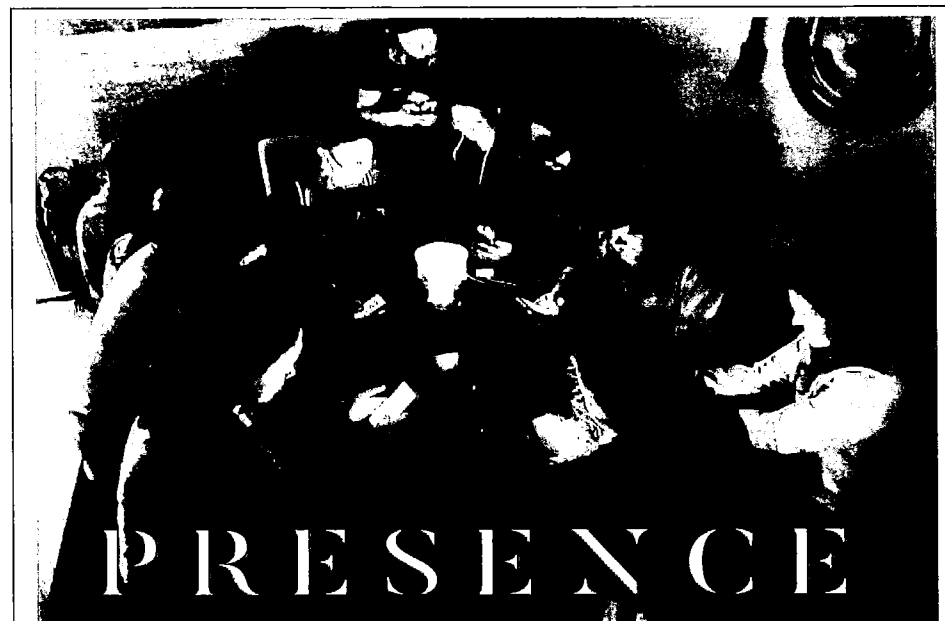

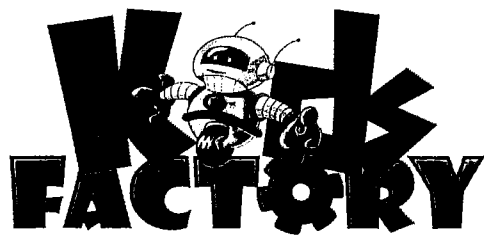

The Late Registration balance of \$162 is due by June 27.

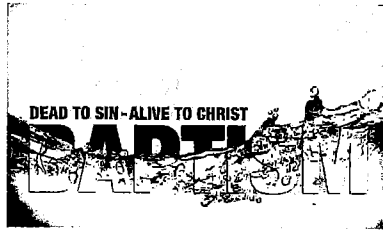
