KAIROS STORY

A few months ago I had an idea to create a group to help people who have lost a parent, since I lost my dad when I was four years old. I wanted to do something to help kids/teens that have gone through a death of a parent as well. The idea started as a website but I didn't tell anyone for a few days. A few days later at school we had a Habitudes presentation with EcoEric who challenged us to make a difference in our community. The school and Habitudes leaders created a competition to support and financially award the best student led project that would create positive change in the community. I felt like it was a sign from God to do something with the idea I had. I decided to make a peer group instead of a website for my project. I told my mom and she told me I could do a group. I loved that idea and decided to enter the competition. I later found out that I made it to the finals along with two other groups and had to present my idea to a board of teachers and staff including the principal. I was the only one doing the project by myself and found that very scary. A few months later there was an assembly held that would declare the winner. My heart was racing so fast during the whole assembly and when they announced the second-place winner, I realized I had won first place. It didn't feel real! I won the competition and now my group, Children of the Angels, will be created! This week we had the first meeting and I couldn't believe it was real. I am so proud to be doing this in honor of my father. I still am so happy to be doing this to help other kids with similar experiences and also do it for the Lord. I am so thankful for all the support and kind words everyone has said!

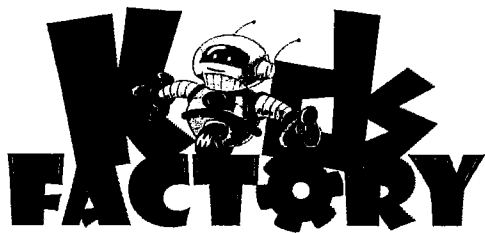

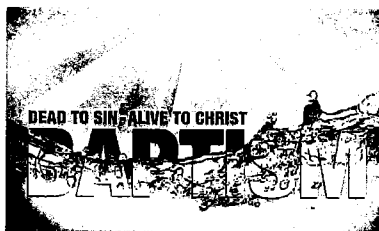

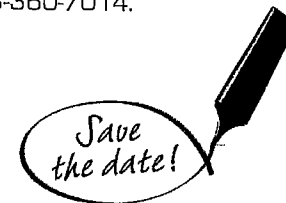
