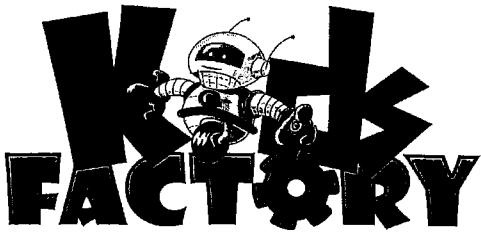
Welcome to Hope Community Church of the Nazarene!

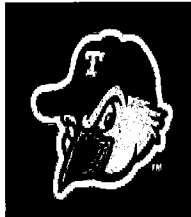
