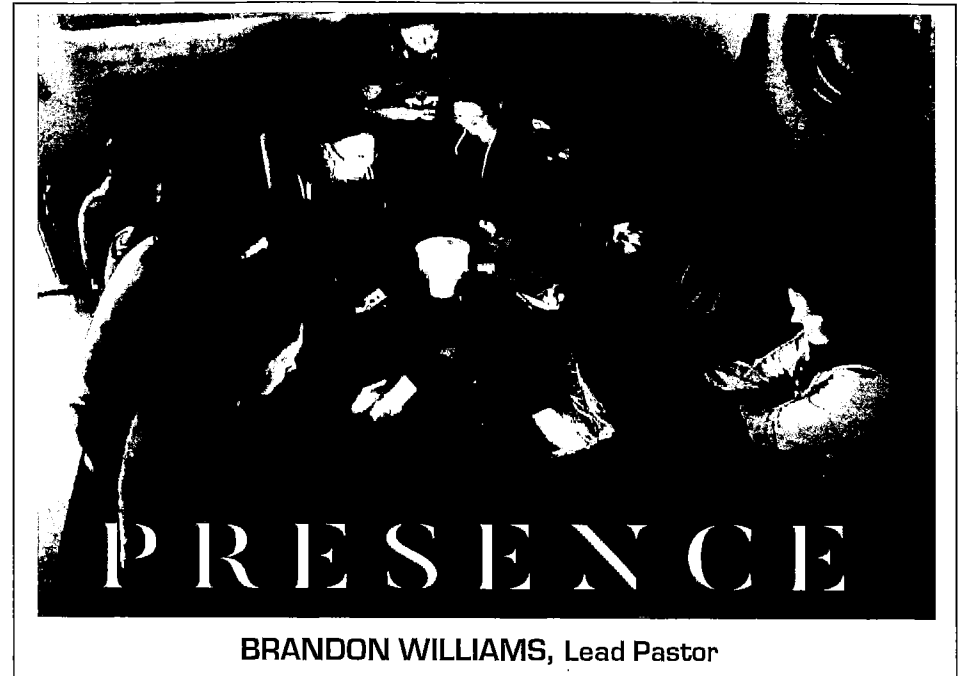

KAIROS STORY

I tend to be selfish. At the end of a long day I find myself doing things that I want to do. One of those things around this time of year is sitting at the pool at my apartment complex. I have my book and music ready for a relaxing evening by the pool. Recently however, whenever I go to the pool, I've been flooded with conversation with the neighbors around me who are also at the pool. Conversations with others range from the newest TV series to why God allows human suffering. More often than not people want to ask questions on who God is and why do I serve Him. In these moments there is a selfish part of me would rather put in my headphones and focus on myself. But God seems to have other plans for me during these moments by the pool. I've been continually hit with these kairos moments where God has been pushing me to go deeper with my neighbors. In these moments I am faced with a choice: do I do what I want to do or do I want to invest in others for God's glory? God has been so incredibly faithful to slow me down and teach me that this life is not about me. These times by the pool, as in John 5:1-14, are times of healing, not only for myself but for my neighbors as the good news is shared with them. 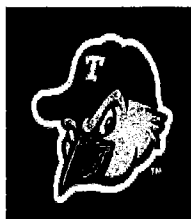
