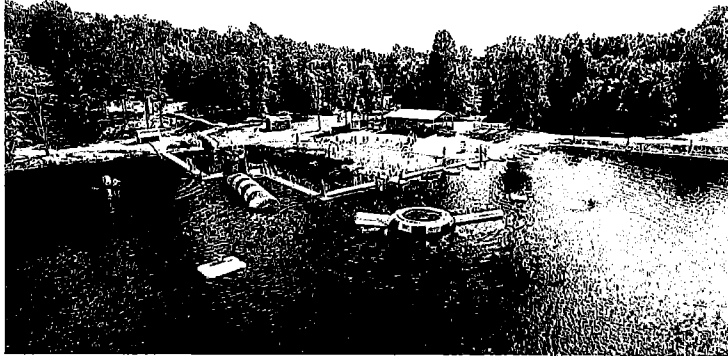


## YOUR GENEROSITY IS CHANGING LIVES

Beyond the conversations held by the water I have also enjoyed seeing the families at the pool teaching their children how to swim. There was one parent in particular who was recently teaching her little girl how to swim. She would start in the shallow end and would back up to allow her child swim to her. As the child improved in strength and stamina the mother would make her way closer to the deep end. I could see the fear in the child's eyes, as mom seemed to be out of reach. The gentle encouragement of the mother's voice gave the child enough courage to just keep swimming. In the same way, as God's children, we are often led into deep waters and feel like we are swimming all alone. But if we slow down we can hear the gentle encouragement of the Father urging us to keep trusting and keep swimming. 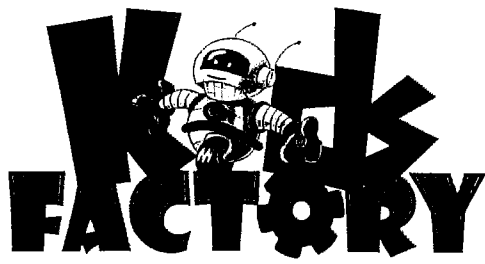

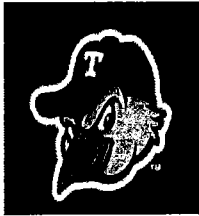
