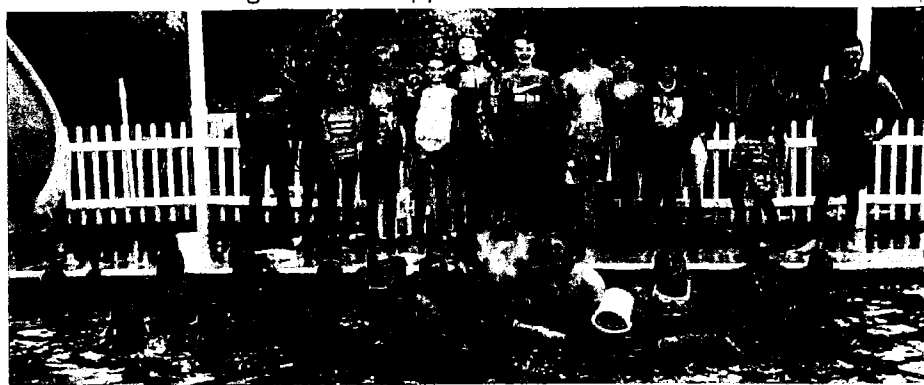


## YOUR GENEROSITY IS CHANGING LIVES

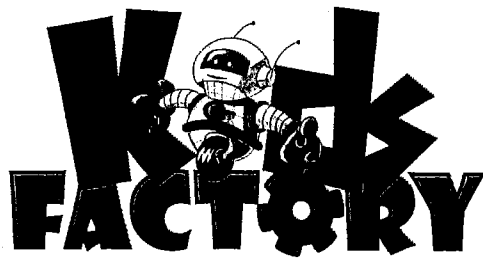
