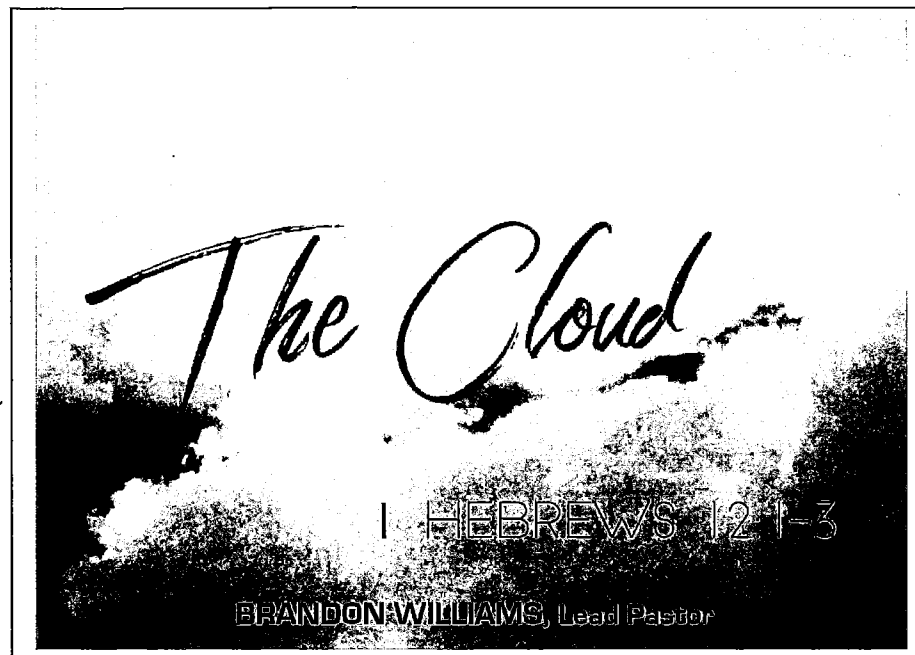

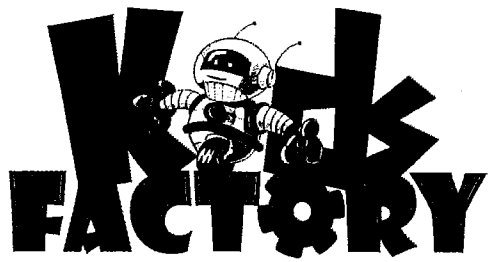

Wired, for 5th and 6th grade students, will not have classes during the summer. Students may volunteer in Kids Factory or attend the worship service.

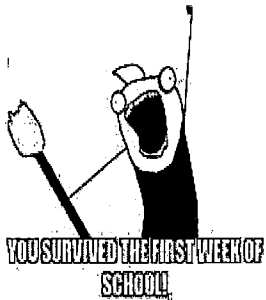


"You Survived the First Week of School" Movie Night
