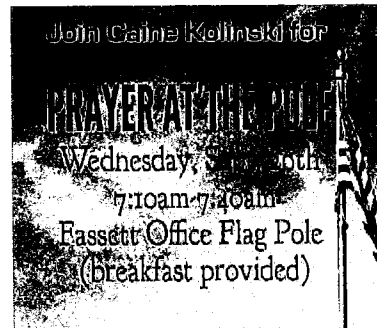
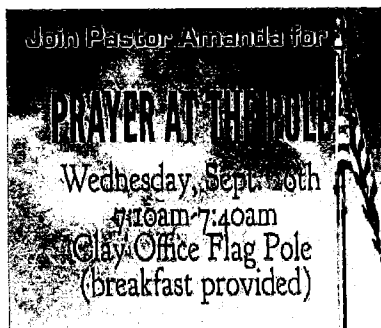


### WELCOME TO HOPE CLASS
