Safe Worship Guidelines

1. **If you are ill or experiencing symptoms of illness (fever, cough, etc.) please refrain from attending.** We will still be live streaming the service via Facebook Live, the Website or **YouTube Live! Please subscribe to our YouTube Page!**
2. The service will **begin promptly at 11am.**
3. Upon entering, please sanitize your hands. We have hand sanitizer stations located outside the front doors.
4. The doors will be opened by our ushers for contactless entrance.
5. There will be **NO children's church or nursery.**
6. We have socially distanced our seating 6 feet apart in family units of 6-8 seats. PLEASE enter promptly and move towards the front. Because of spreading out, we will have to sit in every location. Serve your faith family and choose the seat(s) closest to the front.
7. We will also have seating socially distanced in the dining room as an overflow room. We will have a large TV live broadcasting the service.
8. The Restrooms will be available and supervised by our deacons in case of emergency. We do ask to refrain from using if possible. Only one person or family may enter at a time, and they will be disinfected after each use. We are asking children under 10 to be accompanied by a parent/caregiver.
9. To maintain a contactless worship, we will continue to mail the bulletins to you. It is also on the Carver App (simply search for "Carver Baptist Church" in your App Store and download before arriving).
10. There will be NO welcome time and we are asking people to refrain from hugging and handshakes. **It's ok to smile and wave!**
11. After the service, boxes will be available to drop off your offering located at the entrance. For your convenience, you may still give via the app or website.
12. Please maintain social distancing while on campus.
13. Please cover all sneezes and coughs in your elbow.
