The United Way has identified 400 families in Payne County to serve. Items will be set out for distribution on the west side of the north parking lot. Items to be distributed will be food boxes, hygiene items, and children’s books to these 400 families. There will be 12-15 agency booths (including our church) set up inside the church building.

- 2:00 pm unload food prior to 4:00 pm
- 4:00 pm first 200 families arrive
- 5:00 pm second 200 families arrive
- 6:00 pm clean up by 7:00 pm
