## Hebrews 12:1–2, Psalm 145:4–7 & Ephesians 2:19–22 (NIV)

### Hebrews 12:1-2

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, <sup>2</sup> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

### Psalm 145: 4-7

<sup>4</sup> One generation commends your works to another;  
they tell of your mighty acts.

<sup>5</sup> They speak of the glorious splendor of your majesty—  
and I will meditate on your wonderful works.<sup>[a]</sup>

<sup>6</sup> They tell of the power of your awesome works—  
and I will proclaim your great deeds.

<sup>7</sup> They celebrate your abundant goodness  
and joyfully sing of your righteousness.

### Ephesians 2:19-22

<sup>19</sup> Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and strangers, but fellow citizens with God's people and also members of his household, <sup>20</sup> built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. <sup>21</sup> In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. <sup>22</sup> And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.
