## Directors Note



It was 10 yrs ago this month when I asked 10 teenagers to come and help me with a special project at this church, our first production of "Godspell 2015". I had met most of them at Holbrook High School in the Music/Theater Dept. You see, my oldest daughter Rachel was involved in the after school theater group in 7<sup>th</sup>grade and of course she let them know that her Dad was a musician and would be more than willing to help.

Of course I couldn't let her down and ended up playing the Reed 1 book for Bye Bye Birdie in 2010. Fast forward a couple of years and I am still helping or maybe Music Directing is the correct term. I think it was the spring of 2014 and my kids were going to school there so of course I will help....direct?!?! and they were doing Seussical that year. Samplayed Vlad Vladikov at 8 yrs old. It was about this time that I realized that these kids needed something more. They all really loved drama and the stage and being together. So I pitched doing Godspell here at the church and was approved. My son Noah Hobart played Jesus and Josh Hoerr from the church, played Judas, along with Madison Christian, Rachel Robicheau, my daughter Rachel Hobart, Sarah Ryan, Hayli Manning, Derek Henry, Matt Mullen and Aaron Cohen. Of course, it was a huge success and is also how our story began. We continued doing Summer musicals with this same core group for the next several years. Jesus Christ Superstar in 2016, Guys and Dolls in 2017, Garden of Eden in 2018, Here We Go Round in 2019 an original work by our own David Henkelmann. Then Covid hit. We were able to resume in 2020 with MTI's release of All Together Now Around the World in November 2021. We took another year off and in 2023, took a "leap of faith" by putting out a casting call for RENT. A whole new group of actors auditioned for a chance to recreate Jonathan Larson's rock musical. Since then our theater group continues to evolve and change. We were able to produce Into the Woods in 2024. Which brings us to our 10 yr Anniversary Season. In the winter of 2025 we were brought back several of the original cast to once again revive Godspell 2025. Later in the Spring, under the direction of Emily Burke and Corey Shore, we produced Shakespeare's A Midsummer Nights Dream and now of course Seussical. We have been very fortunate to be able to cultivate such a

Off-Broadway and regional: Lincoln Center Theater's Dessa Rose, The Glorious Ones (both Drama Desk-nominated) and A Man of No Importance (Outer Critics Circle Award, Best Musical); Lucky Stiff; Little Dancer (Kennedy Center world premiere). Film and television credits include A "Christmas Carol" (NBC-TV); Camp (IFC Films); "Schoolhouse Rock" (ABC-TV) and others. (Emmy Award and four Emmy nominations). She is a Council member of the Dramatists Guild of America, a co-founder of the Dramatists Guild Fellows Program, and a Lilly Award winner for Lyrics.

Stephen has also written four musicals at Lincoln Center Theatre: The Glorious Ones (OCC, Drama Desk nominations), Dessa Rose (OCC, Drama Desk nominations), A Man of No Importance (OCC, Best Musical, Drama Desk nomination) and My Favorite Year. Other theater includes In Your Arms (Old Globe), Little Dancer (Kennedy Center), Lucky Stiff (Playwrights Horizons) and Loving Repeating: A Musical of Gertrude Stein (Chicago's Jefferson Award, Best New Musical.) Film includes Anastasia (two Academy Award and two Golden Globe nominations), the documentary After The Storm and Lucky Stiff. Mr. Flaherty's concert music has premiered at the Hollywood Bowl, Boston's Symphony Hall, Carnegie Hall, the Guggenheim Museum and Symphony Space. This year celebrates Stephen's 32-year collaboration with lyricist-librettist Lynn Ahrens. Stephen and Lynn are members of the Dramatists Guild Council and cofounders of the Dramatists Guild Fellows Program. In 2015 they were inducted into the Theater Hall Of Fame. Upcoming: the stage adaptation of Anastasia.




