SERMON TEXT & NOTES

Psalm 1. ¹Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; ² but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night. ³ He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers. ⁴ The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away. ⁵ Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; ⁶ for the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

Blessedness Comes From Righteousness

I. Blessed are Those who Dwell with Righteous People (v. 1)

- Blessedness: It's first relational. It's sometimes material.
 - A permanent state of being under the smile of God
 - o The overflowing life for the pleasure of God

II. Blessed are Those who Delight in Righteous Words (v. 2-3)

- Meditating a murmuring of the truth throughout the day
- Deuteronomy 6:4-9. 4 "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶ And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷ You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸ You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹ You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
