Dear C3 Family,

Because we value our Sunday gatherings so much, we want to take precautions to make these gatherings a safe place. Please help us by following these guidelines for our Sunday corporate gathering.

Venue & Start Time – We're so thankful for our gospel partnerships in the community. *The Baptist Student Ministry* under Joe Schmidt has welcomed us to worship in their building for the foreseeable future. We will meet Sunday's at 10:30am. Parking is readily available across the street from the BSM building at *1612 Lee Street*.

High-Risk Individuals – Persons considered to be at high risk for contracting Covid-19 are encouraged to stay home. *Please visit c3forchrist.org for a link to a live stream of the worship service.* Persons displaying symptoms such as cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste/smell, feeling or running fever over 100 degrees, should stay home as should those who have had contact with persons who have tested positive for Covid-19.

Social Distancing – You may not always be able to stay 6 feet away from one another on Sunday mornings. This is one of the reasons we are requiring masks.

Protective measures – When you enter the BSM building, a greeter will meet you at the door with hand sanitizer. Please use it. *Out of a desire to love and protect one another from Covid-19 we are asking everyone in attendance to wear a mask. If you do not have one, a mask will be provided at the door.* This may seem like an excessive step to take but we want to be on the side of caution as we seek to consider others more significant than ourselves and represent Christ in love of neighbor to prevent further spread of the virus.

Family ministry – We are offering a nursery where teachers are wearing mask and nursery items are sanitized before and after the service. We do not expect children under 3 to wear a mask. Children ages 3-7 have Bible story time during the sermon for about 30 minutes. They are dismissed to their classroom after the last song before the sermon and come back into the service after 30 minutes and participate in the last song and the rest of the service. **Children over three are expected to wear a mask.** We have adult and child sized mask available at the door.

Giving – For those who prefer to give financially at Sunday services, there will be a *giving box* by the front door.

The Lord's Supper – The Lord's Supper will be *self-served* at designated table stations to better ensure that we are handling what we're eating and drinking with care.

Worship Materials – The order of service will be provided *digitally* via email on Sunday morning prior to the service.
