

***A Life of Double Portion: A Study of Elisha***  
**Burn Your Plows 1 Kings 19:19-21; John 14:12**

Today we will look at three invitations God makes to us through the story of Elisha:

1. First, We are Invited to a Higher Calling.

- Sometimes God's call comes to us in unexpected \_\_\_\_\_ at unexpected \_\_\_\_\_.

2. Next, We are Invited to a Deeper Surrender.
