2. Principle Two: Objection Overruled.

- What are your objections?

3. Principle Three: Upon Further Review.

- The Shunammite woman's mission.
- You can't have a resurrection unless you first have a death.
- This story is a picture of what God did for us by sending Jesus.
- Seeking God's perspective.
