The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes from the June 13, 2018 meeting were read and approved. Motion was made by Dale Eenigenburg and seconded by Steve Warren. Motion carried with an 8-0 vote.


Town Manager John Dyke gave an update on Renetta Baraszak 6111 W 100 N. Renetta sold the property and the new owners, Pat Malia & Theresa Bonoma, are in the process of cleaning it up. John will bring photos of the progress at the September meeting.

The Board discussed an animal ordinance. Some changes were made to a chart regarding animals in the different zones. The Board wanted miniature pigs added to the category of animals and added a maximum of 4 animals per lot in a 5-acre residential zone. Motion was made to adopt the changes by Julie Davidson and was seconded by Rick Herma. Motion carried with an 8-0 vote.

Attorney Gordon Etzler reported on the Baumgarte, 5301 W 1175, clean-up process. The family has paid 50% of the fines and are expected to pay 25% more in the coming week. Attorney Etzler informed the Board of his retirement and the possibility of his replacement. He is willing to help make the transition and could submit a resume of who he recommends.

Steve Warren motioned to adjourn at 7:30 p.m. Dale Eenigenburg seconded. Motion passed with an 8-0 vote.
